FULL-TIME EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANT

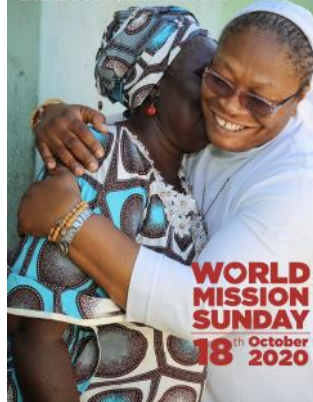
[Sacred Heart School](#) is advertising for a position of full-time Educational Assistant in a limited duration capacity through to June 2021.

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the

responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will continue to be used until 2020 to assist six dioceses in Northern Canada for which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation.
