The latest notice of restrictions issued by the Provincial Health Officer says:

- Sunday, 10:00 AM Mass**

As noted on the notice of restrictions, “Funerals, weddings and baptisms may proceed with a limited number of people and a COVID-19 Safety Plan in place. You can have a maximum of 10 people attend, including the officiant.”
